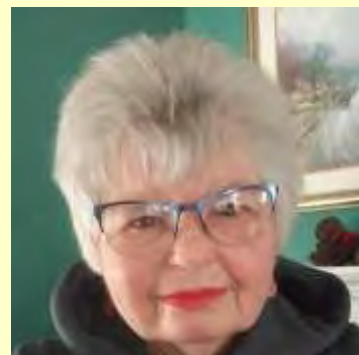
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PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

CHEW ON THIS

Those who know me know I love agility. The sport is rather addicting (kind of like acquiring Schips) and for me I have learned to treasure that human/Schip synergy where we run “as one” around a course. Running “as one” with speed is even more addicting.

There was a time when I was more focused on results, like getting that Q (a Q being a qualifying run). Qs lead to advancement in levels, to titles, to agility championships, to national competitions. Qs can mean recognition as a successful team. At AKC agility trials fellow competitors and friends will frequently ask “did you Q?” as if that is the best outcome one can have. But is it?

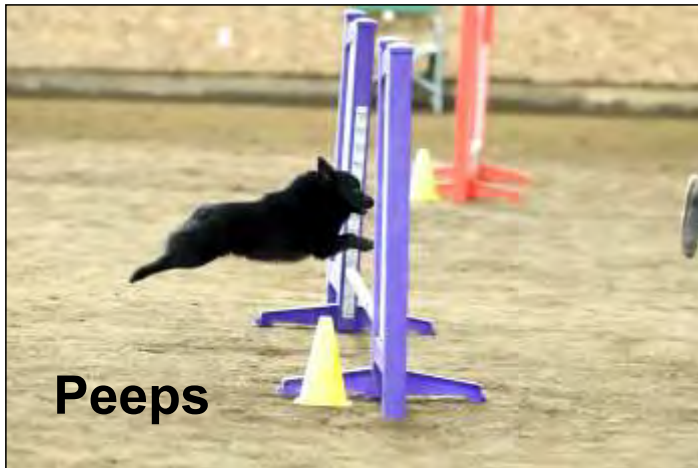
I love getting Qs. But after years of competing, I have come to appreciate how well I communicate with my dog along the course: Is a Q a badge of honor or a “successful” outcome when I mishandled something on course and caused my Schip grief or frustration? I'm lucky I don't have Schips that bark or spin at me when frustrated but I do

have one currently who will shut down and start trotting to indicate his displeasure when I have misdirected him. To those who don't do agility, imagine a comparable situation: You are driving a car and your passenger suddenly says, without warning, TURN LEFT NOW! And you are in the wrong lane to do this. Frustrating, right? A potential accident in the works! Agility is all about communication with one's toes and arms and shoulders as well as voice. As a rehab veterinarian (and high-level agility competitor) once told me, agility doesn't hurt dogs, but bad handling can.



Once an agility handler starts competing, the desire to progress as quickly as possible to the next level can become a goal. Goals are fine, but speaking from experience my advice to any handler is to take a good look at one's skills and teamwork before advancing, even if it means not trialing for a while. Granted, the Catch-22 here is that a team can be terrific in practice but that same terrific teamwork falls apart in the trial environment. It's a tough situation and a lot of teams keep plowing through courses at trials, hoping things will eventually come together. And sometimes they do, but again, ask the question: “Am I providing the best information to my dog as I run a course? Or, do I need to improve my skills?” Ninety nine percent of the time an NQ is due to handler error, yet many handlers will blame the dog.

If one thinks about agility (or any dog sport for that matter) as an opportunity to learn instead of focusing on results, the journey will be that much more successful and fun for both the dog and human. Fixing bad handling and retraining muscle memory is a pain. Novice handlers with novice dogs have a steep learning curve and frequently aren't prepared for the trial environment, particularly the psychological aspect for both human and dog: Is the dog shy or nervous in a trial environment? Is the handler stressed out in a trial environment? Can a handler mentally handle not getting a Q, and what is the psychological result of that? How does that affect the team? Does the handler put more



pressure on a dog or take a step back and truly analyze the state of partnership? These are just a few questions a good agility instructor can have with a novice agility handler, but from what I've observed a lot of times these kinds of discussions don't happen.

I've been working with a particular agility instructor for over 10 years who, from the very beginning of our working together, emphasized what could be categorized as the journey, not the outcome. While I heard and understood what she was saying, did I always follow her advice? Nope, because it's all too easy to succumb to peer pressure ("did you Q?"), or

feel the need to prove oneself, or whatever ... the influences to show an outcome (a Q, or title, etc.) are real. Frustrations are real. I'm sure at times my dogs have thought I was a real weirdo walking into the ring (why is mom so stressed?).

When I "let go" and walk into the trial ring with a smile on my face like I do in practice, the synergy is there. I have learned to focus on what goes RIGHT on course as opposed to what went wrong and take note of both. Granted, this isn't always easy as expectations have a way of creeping onto one's shoulders like a nasty little negative gremlin. Again, having a trainer who can help coach students through these issues means the agility journey (which never ends, by the way) will be that much sweeter. Students of agility should recognize that the sport requires psychological as well as physical training and teamwork. Think about both to be the best you can be. That Schip at the start line will love you for it.



Deb Bruner has been training and competing in agility for 12+ years. She has trained, or is in the process of training, 7 Schips, putting AKC and NADAC agility titles on all of them. Blitz, retired now, was her biggest teacher and he was the 2nd Schip in the U.S. to earn his AKC Agility Grand Championship title (he also earned multiple PACHs and NADAC Champion titles as well as titles in numerous other sports and conformation). She and her Schip clan live in Bellingham, WA.

What is Reiki

What is “Reiki”?

(Part 1 of 3)

Reiki is an energy healing technique which can help deliver “energy” to your body to help promote relaxation, reduce stress and anxiety, and support your body in healing – physical, emotional, mental.

This was developed by Mikao Usui in the early 1900s – the term deriving from the Japanese words rei – meaning universal – and ki – referring to the vital life force energy that flows through all living things.

It is used throughout the world as a complementary modality to aid in healing, assisting traditional medical and therapeutic treatments, and helping all living beings to become more energetically balanced (physically, emotionally, mentally, and spiritually.)

Reiki promotes relaxation – stress reduction – and symptom relief – to improve one's overall health and well-being.

If you are in overall good health – it can enhance your ability to respond to stress and act as a form of preventative medicine.

Reiki is universal life force energy – therefore, it is not aimed specifically at any one particular “ailment” in the body – but as an overall treatment for the entire living being (again, physically, emotionally, mentally and spiritually.)

Reiki practitioners always ask permission first to offer this energy treatment to you – and when you answer in the affirmative, they can offer this positive energy to flow from their hands to you. Some will do a hands-off treatment – others will place hands on, depending upon the person receiving the treatment. Both are equally effective, as the energy will flow from the practitioner to the person/animal, and go to wherever it is most needed in the body.

Some may feel a tingling sensation, or a wave of heat or pulsing, as this positive energy is directed from the practitioner's hands to them. Others will just feel very relaxed and peaceful.

Reiki practitioners will ground (focus inward, not let outward influences or stresses affect them) themselves before a treatment – and set the “intention” of the treatment to be for your highest good, to go to where the energy is needed in the body.

Reiki with Animals

(Part 2 of 3)

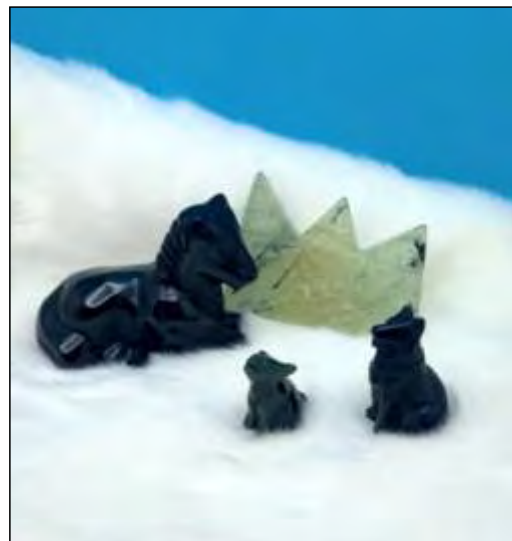
Animals are very energetic creatures and as such, will be openly receptive to Reiki energies. They are very in tune with nature!

Personally, I find it best to sit with the animal – using a “hands off” approach, offering up Reiki energies to the animal, and just letting the animal settle into this new feeling that is around them. The energy that will come to them when you offer Reiki, may feel both good and at the same time, unusual, to them.

Some companion animals may be wary; they may wander around the room, or possibly pace back and forth. They are trying to figure out “hmm, what is this?” This is why I personally approach with the hands-off technique when offering up Reiki energy to animals.

If the animal settles into a comfortable position and wants to be near me, or even climb up into my lap, of course I go with the moment. A very gentle light touch is used, and not necessarily aimed at any particular part of the animal's body.

Reiki energies will flow to wherever they are most needed. This is true of whether you are offering Reiki to people or animals. Reiki energy is for everything in the universe – be it people, animals, livestock, wild creatures, anything!



Many animals have suffered trauma and Reiki energy can assist them – over time – to deal with this. It may take some pets longer than others to overcome what has taken place in their lives before they came to live with their current owners. One cannot rush into this. The animal will take the amount of time that is necessary for them to personally get past things that have occurred in their lives.

Animals need to become comfortable with the practitioner – as well as with the energy that they feel flowing to them. Some companion pets may settle in immediately and feel a strong emotional release from past trauma at an initial session. Others may take many sessions and it may seem that they are not progressing, but they are merely doing it “on their own timetable.” The pet owner, as well as the practitioner, needs to be mindful of this, and allow the animal to heal at their own pace.

The pet's owner may want to undergo some Reiki sessions as well, so that they can let go of the feeling of wanting to shield and protect their pet from any harm. This can bring in the element of fear that the pet will feel, and inhibit the moving forward and healing from past traumatic events.

When the pet owner is confident in the animal's ability to accept positive energy when offered, that will be felt by the pet as well. This will help them progress into living a life free of the feelings their past trauma has caused in them.

Not all pets have trauma to overcome. They might undergo surgery that is routine (such as spay/neuter or dental) and become confused by the pain and the separation from their owner, even though only for a short period of time. Reiki energy can assist in moving past this.

Some animals may be naturally nervous, for no apparent reason. Reiki can assist in overcoming this, allowing them to move forward in life with a calmer demeanour and not be overwhelmed with unusual situations.

Livestock as well as animals in the wild can benefit from Reiki as well. The practitioner will sit near them, but not “in their space”, settling in calmly, and offer energy to them while maintaining a proper distance.

Animals are very intuitive and will accept Reiki energy offered to them, and it will go to where it is needed the most!

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Part 3 – “Reiki Distance Sessions”

What is “Distance” Animal Reiki?

Part 3 of 3

Reiki practitioners are able to “send” healing universal energy across space and time. It is not in any way lesser than, or inferior to, in person sessions.

In fact, with animals, it might be the preferable way to offer them Reiki energy, for a number of reasons!

Animals that are traumatized may spend the treatment time “in person” simply reacting to the practitioner instead of settling quietly and being open to receiving Reiki energy offered to them. Those that tend to “react” rather than just simply “observe” in their world – have this problem removed in a distance session. They simply can rest and receive, and in this way, spend the session absorbing the positive energy being offered – rather than “being on guard” and wondering what “bad thing” might happen with this new human in their vicinity.

A quiet place for both the practitioner and the animal are all that is needed. The session then proceeds in the same manner – the practitioner will ground themselves, ask permission of the animal to offer the experience, and proceed with offering healing energies to the animal – to be used for where they may be needed, for the higher good of the animal.

Reiki energies will always flow to where they will do the most good – nobody has to “force” anything, in any way, whatsoever.

And as always with animals, healing energies offered are not a substitute for veterinary care. The practitioner does not need to know the issue, unless the owner wishes to disclose it. This does not determine how the energies flow or are used by the animal. There may be a medical issue that is not possible to be treated – and in this case, the energies may simply flow to the animal to assist it on its way out of this world, to move on from the pain that they are experiencing in their body.

If surgery has recently been completed, the energies may possibly flow to aid in the healing treatment. This is not necessarily always physical – sometimes the act of surgery itself has caused trauma within the animal, and Reiki can assist in helping the animal to recover from this trauma, thereby clearing the way for physical healing in the body as well.

A change of home – or owner – may be the issue. Reiki energies can help the pet to accept the new situation, to understand that this is for a better life ahead. It is possible the pet's owner has passed away, which is often extremely distressing for animals. Having loving energy flowing to them can assist them in moving on and assimilating easier into a new life with a new human to care for them.

Animals are very open and receptive to Reiki energies – never underestimate the power of animals to accept and heal!

From The Archives...the beginnings...

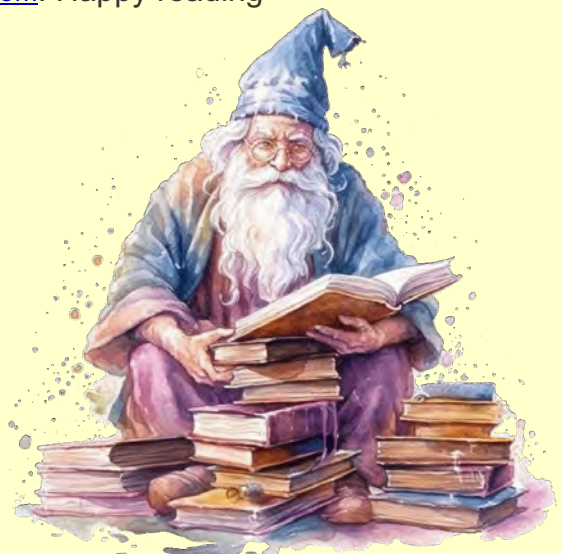
