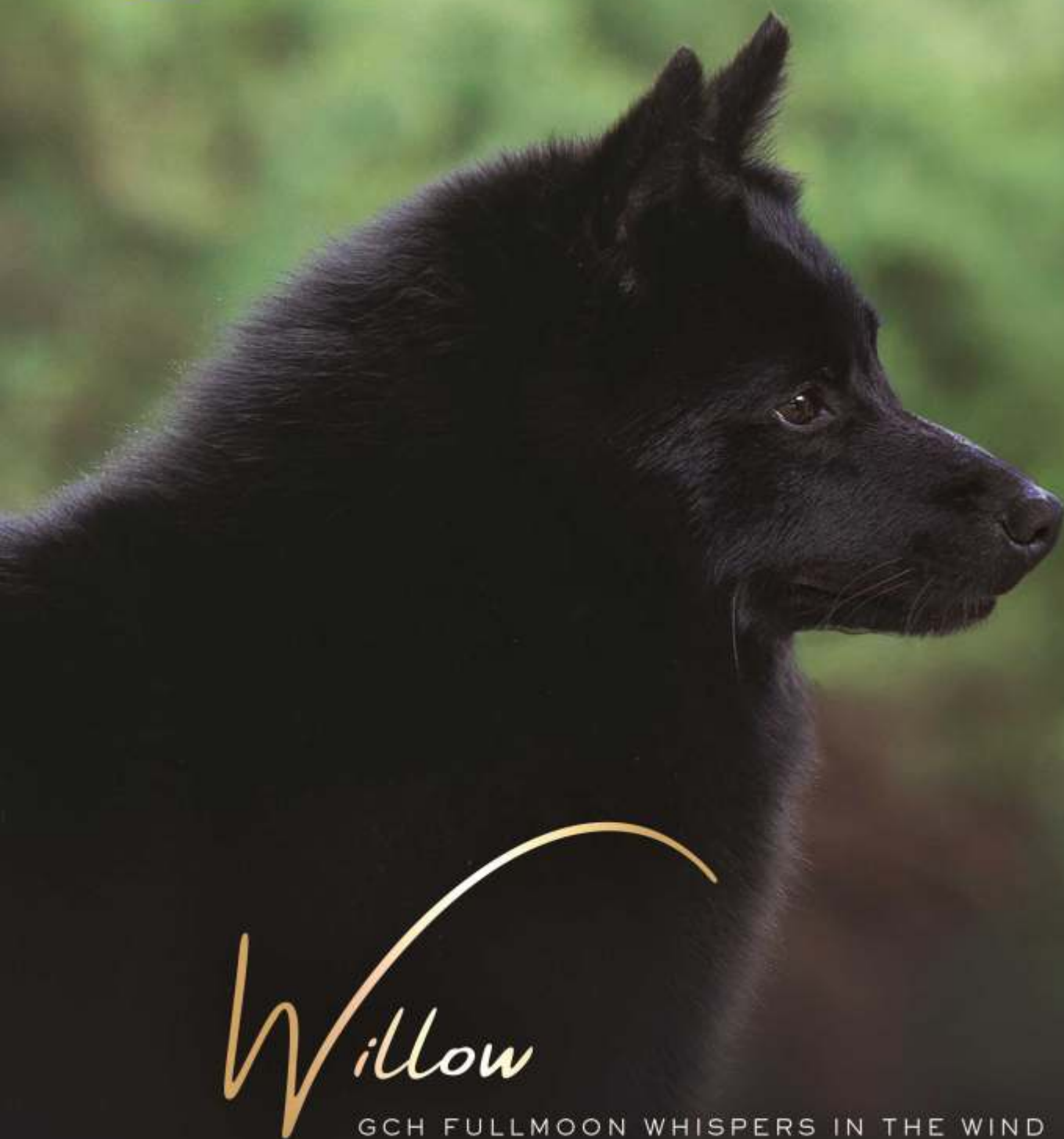

THE TRUTH ABOUT MENTORING

I grow tired of hearing about the changes in our sport. We all know it is happening, and we see the difference between today and where we were when we got involved in the sport those many years ago. In many ways, it is sad: the decline in numbers; the change of traditions; and the loss of pillars of our community. We can all lament the changes in our sport, but I prefer to think of ways to reinvent it without losing focus on the core aspect of breeding better dogs.

I see the dog world as simply a smaller microcosm of the world at large, and there are so many outside factors that are contributing to our sport's decline. Our beloved sport is challenged by the economy, attrition, gas prices, too many shows, too few breeders, too many new judges, and not enough new exhibitors.

There are many in the fancy who are well aware of the differences between “then” and “now.” But as time passes, that list of fanciers grows shorter. It's simple math. Fewer people are around today who remember the good ole days. There are fewer who realize the differences from what we're experiencing now and what happened in yesteryear. For those newer to the sport, this is what they know, and for them, THIS will be “the way it was” as they grow older in the sport. So, welcome to their good old days!

This is part of the frustration for those us who are “long-haulers” in the sport. We know the way it was—the how it was and the how it used to be. Seeing where the sport is today, and where it is obviously heading, is our struggle to bear. Those of us who are “lifers” are concerned about the rapid turnover of newcomers to the sport, the growing number of shows, and the declining talent both in the ring and in the whelping box. We are all too aware that those giants and pillars in our sport, those who worked to define our breeds, who worked to define judging styles and worked with breeders to improve the foundation of the breeds they were showing, are considered ancient history by newer fanciers AND are viewed merely as folklore.

I have been very fortunate to have had many good mentors. These great dog men and women coached me, counseled me, and guided the very foundation of my breeding program. They took the time to teach me, and I was a sponge. I was open, and I wanted to learn from them. The sport took me under its wing. Now, nearly four decades later, I am still the positive recipient of those opportunities. I still think about those conversations, with great admiration for those whose experience has benefited me. The advice that I received from people who had been doing for years what I was just beginning to do was invaluable to me.

Yet today, the ability to pay that information forward is more of a challenge. Our audience has changed. For the most part, the influx of individuals seeking to become successful (quickly) includes those who are too self-absorbed to be receptive to the mentorship we once were provided. Today, the opinions of experienced breeders and exhibitors are not often sought after—and many times they are simply dismissed or just ignored. However, this great sport is not lacking for mentors. The sport is lacking individuals who realize, or who can acknowledge, they need a mentor. There is an epidemic of individuals who seek a rapid rise to fame, a quick fix to get a big win. They won't invest time, but they will pay to advance. They want to bypass the hard work. They are not interested in taking two, three, or more weeks off to sit in the whelping box to breed a litter, and they're too impatient to watch a puppy grow and develop. They would prefer to bypass the areas that truly engage you as a breeder in the true meaning and value behind the sport. Unfortunately, they aren't interested in the hard work, the emotional lows, the heartbreak, and the failures that come with breeding dogs.

I want to share the story of two sisters, born in a beautiful litter of puppies bred by a newcomer to one of my own breeds. The young starlet breeder, who was full of self-confidence, completely and totally in control of her decisions and well-versed in superficial schooling, was, to her discredit, unable to be mentored. She was unable to be coached, unable to be trained, and in her mind, she was a mentor and certainly did not need one. She wasn't interested in learning or listening. She was more interested in being important. She wanted to make the decisions. She wanted to be right. The breeders who are reading know this type well, since she exists in many forms. We have all experienced her before.

The lovely litter was brought up for our evaluation, but soon we realized that the process was only for us to learn what she had decided about the litter. She informed us, the co-breeders, of the placements; where they would be going, which puppy was show quality, which was pet quality, and which bitch puppy she would be keeping. Upon evaluation of the litter, with the eyes of 20 years (at the time) of dedication to the sport—learning the breeds, evaluating many litters, and having an eye for the breed—I informed the young ingénue that she was keeping the wrong bitch. My suggestion fell on deaf ears. She had made her decision and knew what she wanted. She was strong in her opinions and comfortable with her decision. I immediately kept the other bitch, who had been deemed “pet quality” and already had a home lined up.

This is not an unusual story. I am sure many readers have “been there, done that” before. It happens all the time. The novice person picks with their emotions, but the experienced breeder uses their working knowledge of the breed's key elements to sort and grade the litter to make their final decision.

Returning to the story, the two bitch puppies from that litter obtained their American Kennel Club Championships and passed all of the required genetic testing so that they could be bred and produce future generations. The bitch that was selected by the ingénue breeder produced a very small litter of inconsequential puppies by a stud dog of her choice. The sister, that we'd determined was show quality, went on to win the National Specialty twice. She produced multiple offspring to win Groups and Specialties, a National Specialty winner, and many offspring to win majors at the prestigious American Spaniel Club. She would go on to produce the top winner in the breed's history.

I have often looked back at this litter as a huge missed opportunity for the starlet breeder, because she was so unwilling to learn and because she was so unwilling to listen. She missed out on generations of higher quality. She has done what so many do—ignore the guide. She decided she didn't need the advice of experts and went on her own way. Today, I imagine her decision must haunt her. Or does she even know that she missed her opportunity. Her “line” has never advanced from that very decision. She missed the greatest opportunity of her dog breeding career. She stood in her own way, and let her ego prevent her from seeing the opportunities before her. The successful breeders have all seen this before.

Breeding dogs is a challenge, we all know this, but newer breeders have to be open to listening and hearing what someone with experience sees before solidifying a decision that could very well be wrong. It's important to remember that every journey needs a guide. You don't start breeding dogs without the understanding that you will need some help along the way. It is important to look for, and take advantage of, the support around you. Part of your job as a breeder is to seek out a guide.

Our story is not uncommon or unique. In fact, we have had this happen many times over the course of 40 years. I have assured both bitch owners and stud dog owners to just hold on and let your mentor guide you to the best decision possible. Newcomers must learn to trust their guides and be open to their years of successful experience; be open to their vision that has produced the nine or twelve generations of dogs behind your choice of a brood bitch or stud dog. Allow their expertise to help you form your own opinion, which will happen over the course of many years to come. Be sure to take advantage of their stature and position, and celebrate it with them. Start your journey with them, and over time you can start your own path with the knowledge of years of investment in that mentorship.

Mentoring is a long-haul process. It starts with an exchange, generally of one dog to a buyer, and it develops across the next five to ten years of a mutual understanding and respect. While you are developing your relationship, as an apprentice who will eventually take the position of a new breeder, you will develop an ability to make educated decisions. You will experience your own highs and lows. You will move forward and create your own identity, and over time you will start to identify your individuality and produce something that truly represents your own unique vision in your breed.

To be fair, your first litter is not your own vision. It is the shared vision with you and your guide. It is literally a combination of two other people's vision. Generally, this is the point where you start to develop a path that is your

own. This is often four to six years in the sport and many steps down that path with an experienced mentor. The hope is that during this time you are consistently and actively collecting information and education from those who have been there before you.

Seek out the most successful people in other breeds around you. Watch and learn from me, too. After all of this time as a breeder and a mentor, I will tell you that, more often than not, the best mentors come from outside of your own breed. Search for breeders who live close to you, maybe at your local shows, who are consistently successful. Top breeders are all over the place, in all areas of our country. Know that the very best among us will continue for multiple decades, dedicated to the sport of purebred dogs and sharing our compassion for animals, the passion for creating animals that are healthy and strong. This is what keeps us motivated...that thrill of producing a dog that reflects your interpretation of the written Breed Standard.

For those who might be challenged in their own breeding program, I suggest you consider reaching out to anyone you respect, and ask them to help you. You will not be disappointed. Ask them to guide you, to be a mentor. You are never alone in this sport. If you want to invest the time, there is a talented mentor willing to share knowledge with you. Of this, I am sure!

In Addition: By Geri Hart

I am very appreciative of the permission to reprint this article for the *Bulletin*. Doug and I grew up in the same part of the country, in the same era, shared mentors, and hold very similar viewpoints. If you are newer to the sport, I encourage you to read and re-read his article. He makes many important points, and I would like to add a few more of my own.

Both Doug and I have been fortunate to be involved in more than one breed. I grew up with Golden Retrievers. My mother began in Goldens in the early 1960s and was guided by one of the best mentors available at the time. She purchased her first two dogs from this breeder. The second finished quickly and went on to become a National Specialty winner, a multiple Best in Show winner, and an Outstanding Sire. Despite this early success, her mentor would not “allow” her to breed a first litter for at least two years. During that time, she studied pedigrees, learned structure, and spent countless hours at shows absorbing knowledge. She watched successful handlers and sought out structure and movement experts such as Rachel Page Elliot, the author of *Dog Steps*, a book I highly recommend for all potential exhibitors and breeders.

I was raised immersed in Goldens and the breed became second nature to me. Schipperkes were our secondary breed until I was in college, when I decided to make them my own. I was also fortunate to spend a decade working with English Cocker Spaniels. My mother helped me connect with excellent mentors in “Engies” and guided me in purchasing dogs from accomplished breeders willing to teach pedigrees, structure, and the fundamentals of breeding. The results were rewarding: I bred numerous champions, including a specialty and Best in Show winner who was also the #1 English Cocker.

My mother's goal, which has become my mantra, was never to breed the most litters, nor to breed for money, fame, or ego. She was taught early that the goal is to produce dogs as close to the standard as possible while maintaining health. If success follows while holding fast to these principles, even better! Malagold Golden Retrievers look remarkably similar today to those from the late 1960s, with a consistent and recognizable style. We have never chased popular sires or trends. To this day, I remain my own harshest critic and only breed when I aim to produce something for myself, in both Goldens and Schipperkes.

Because the Schipperke is not a highly populated breed, and there are fewer large breeding programs, finding a mentor can be more difficult. In the 1970s and 1980s, I was fortunate to learn from greats such as Frances Griggs (Skipalong), Dorris Hearing (Landmark), and Ellen Stephens (ARES), who were generous with their knowledge. As Doug points out, many people seek overnight success and

bypass mentorship altogether - an observation that is absolutely accurate. However, in low-registration breeds, the challenge can also be finding the right mentor in the first place.

When evaluating potential mentors, pay close attention to how they interact with others. Do they collaborate with fellow breeders and handlers, or are they isolated? Do they seek outside opinions, or believe they already know it all? Are they truly working for the betterment of the breed, or for personal recognition or their own ego? Even long-time, successful breeders can fall into this trap. In many breeds, we see declines in structure and movement due to overbreeding or poor selection. Also consider whether they fully health test their breeding stock and maintain proper care—heartworm prevention, parasite control, and appropriate housing. These details absolutely matter.

Equally important is how a mentor treats you. Are they accessible? Do they treat you with respect and give you meaningful time? If not, they may not be the right fit.

If you've purchased a dog from a mentor, were you provided with complete health documentation? As the dog matures, do you feel you were sold a true show prospect, not just their seconds? More importantly, is the dog a structurally sound breeding prospect? A good mentor should prioritize teaching you pedigrees, structure, and how to evaluate breeding stock. Your success, or failure, reflects on them as well. If support disappears after the sale, that is not a true mentor. Seek others.

Finally, whether you have a mentor, or are still looking for one, learning requires effort and presence. Attend shows early and spend time ringside observing not just your breed, but many others. Too often, newcomers arrive just before their class and leave immediately afterward. Stay for group and Best in Show judging. Watch how successful handlers prepare their dogs, how they use their hands on a dog, how efficiently they stack and present, and how subtle and unobtrusive their movement is in the ring. Approach those you admire, explain that you are eager to learn, and ask questions. Be humble - the response may surprise you.

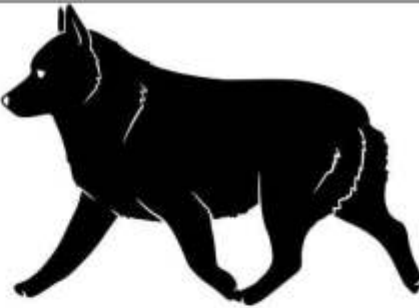

2026 Judge Critiques

Thank you to the club for inviting me to judge your beautiful breed!

I started by judging a great entry of Schipperkes on Monday at the Rally trial. There were some very nice performances and I think that almost everyone qualified. This is a very athletic breed and handled the jumps very well. Most of the dogs were very attentive to their handlers. There were some missteps here and there, but all the exhibitors seemed to enjoy their time in the ring and congratulated each other! Very few Schipperkes show in Rally in my area of the country, and it was great to see such a nice entry.

I had a very nice entry in the conformation ring and had some difficult decisions to make. I looked for correct heads, correct coat patterns, and correct proportions. A couple of my winners were slightly out of coat and I did not hold it against them.

My winner's dog came from the 9 to 12 puppy dog class, and the reserve winners dog, came from the bred by exhibitor class. Both had beautiful heads with the correct eye shape, correct coat pattern and both moved exceedingly well.

My winners and reserve winners bitches, both came from the bred by exhibitor classes. My winners bitch was probably one of my best movers of the day and she went onto Best of Winners. The puppy Bred by winner was also very nice.

My veteran dogs and bitches hardly showed their ages. The 10-12 year old winner was especially nice.

I had a great group of specials and made several cuts, sometimes eliminating dogs that I did like. My final choice for Best of Breed came down to three entries, my eventual Best of Breed dog, my Select dog, and my Best of Opposite sex bitch.

My BOB dog was one I liked from the moment he stepped into the ring! Very nice head, correct proportions, beautiful coat and exceptional movement! My BOS girl, was very feminine, and also a very good mover. She was in great condition, with a beautiful coat.

I also liked my Select dog very much. He was very well presented by someone I believe was not his owner. My Select bitch and all my Award of Merit winners were of great quality.

I put a big emphasis on correct movement! This breed should have good reach and drive and I looked for it in all my exhibits. All other things being equal, movement was my deciding factor in many cases.

The line up of Schips was lovely. All were in good health and coat. There are always a couple who shed just after the entry is mailed! No matter.

Several selections got down to the nitty-gritty elements as competition was strong. There were variations in looks but all still with in the standard. Heads can change ever so slightly due to ear set, eye placement, muzzle length and even the size of the dog. Structure was good and movement was sound. A couple was getting on the large size a couple were a little long and a couple fronts were off. All in all though very nice.

BOB line up was terrific. So many deserving of that Champion Title. My selections were based on that all important silhouette, cobby but not thick and well proportioned. I favored a sound, balanced, and strong gait but not one overreaching. Lastly there was attitude galore!

I would commend all the exhibitors on their good sportsmanship. I know the National is where everyone wants to win and I thank all the exhibitors who showed under me. The presentation of the Skips was excellent.

The hotel ran the event smoothly the staff were accommodating and friendly. The ring was spacious and area for vendors and grooming adequate. I heard that hotel management kept the Skip people confined to the first 3 floors; this is a good idea instead of sprinkling exhibitors throughout all floors of the hotel. This hotel had gas, restaurants and a grocery store within walking distance - very convenient.

I would like to give a special THANKS to two women, Ruth Levesque and Katharine Baptiste. Ruth was the Event Chair and kept everything running smoothly; from the time I accepted the assignment to the end of the show and kept me informed of everything I needed to know. She is a treasure and the type of member that clubs need and we are unfortunately losing at a fast rate. Katharine, although not appointed by the club kindly picked us up at the airport and provided us transportation many times to restaurants with no complaints. What a gem. Thanks to you both.

As a general overview to the entry in the classes the dogs were of a higher quality than the bitches, this was reversed in the Best of Breed competition where the quality of the bitches greatly surpassed the dogs. One thing that did surprise me was that there were approximately 10 of the entries that had bad bites; less than level and a few with loss of contact. Breeders must be cautious that this trait does not sneak itself into the breed. I think breeders need also pay more attention to the "ruff" as we are getting a plushier fitted coat with less distinction of the ruff. Coats in general had the harsher texture that is appreciated in the breed. And, as always, movement was all over the place and good movement should be a trait breeders strive for.

Now to the classes, for Winners Dog I pulled 3 males that I felt was the cream of the crop. WD was from the 6-9 puppy class #11

Fullmoon This is Me spotted him the moment he came into the ring, short backed, excellent topline, lovely head and nice coat with very puppy movement. RWD American Bred #61 **Fullmoon Don't Stop Me** Now another dog with a short back, nice coat and topline, good ruff and nice ear set. Also pulled was the 9-12 puppy dog #19 **Delamer Across the Sea to Sunfire** nice silhouette and topline, nice ear set and eye shape should mature into a lovely adult. For WB 2 bitches caught my eye WB came from the BBE Adult class #70 **Delamer Isle of Diamonds** this bitch was in faultless condition, substantial a little more head than I like. She presented herself beautifully, great topline and silhouette great front and rear and a coat to die for. RWB was from the 12 - 18 bitch class #30 **Delamer Black Pearl at Dideb** a very nice bitch more refined than WB nicely built, great topline when she matures she will be tough competition.

What a spectacular site when some 70 Schipperkes were in the ring for the start of the Best of Breed competition. It took a while to get this huge entry down to the best of the best, but it was a pleasure to finally award Best of Breed to the 4 1/2 year old bitch #140, **Ch Fullmoon Whispers in the Wind**, a beautiful example of correct Skip type. She has a lovely silhouette, slopping topline and a nice ruff. She has an exquisite head, small ears and nice eyes that made for a beautiful expression; nice movement and a beautiful free stacker. It was a pleasure to find her in this competitive entry. Best of Opposite Sex was #83 **GCHG Whispering Pines Lover Boy BCAT DM DS**, he is 12 yr. old from the veteran dog #83 he is a larger heavy boned male but shows no coarseness. He has a beautiful head, ear set and eye. His silhouette is great with a good front and rear and excellent movement. Select Dog was #103 **CH Victoria TopperLyn Dragondancer** a smaller totally typey male, excellent topline, nice head and ear set; he is clean moving coming and going, a very nice schipperke. Select bitch was #148 **GCHG Delamer Summer Sand Elle** a larger bitch in beautiful coat with great showmanship. She stands straight front and rear, has a nice head with no coarseness. Nice eye and ear set one of the smoothest movers in the specialty. The club allowed 5 Awards of Merit: #135 **GCHS Ch Rivendel's Prince of Thieves** a coaty, cobby male with a lovely coat and nice ruff, he could move well when he wanted to. #144 **CH Willows Forbidden Kiss @ Sailor's** a very balanced correct bitch, excellent condition and a good mover. #136 **GCH Delamer the Bahamas is Where Isle Be TKN BCAT** an elegant slightly longer backed bitch with beautiful side movement. #106 Vet Bitch 8 - 10 yrs at **GCH Tumbleweed's 99 in the Shade at Malagold** a smaller compact bitch, nice type, square and in great coat. #110 Vet Bitch 10 -12 yrs **GCHS Ch Rivendel's Chasing Rainbows** very showy animated bitch, nice silhouette although over groomed. There was one other bitch who stood out quality wise amongst those pulled for final consideration and this was **GCHS Ch Deloran's On Board Viking** an exceptional bitch of great type and showmanship I would have loved to have an Award of Merit rosette to present to this bitch.

A Look At ROM / ROMX / HOF

The purpose of the ROM, ROMX, and HOF is to recognize and preserve excellence within the breed. The Register of Merit (ROM), Register of Merit Excellent (ROMX) and Hall of Fame (HOF) honor sires and dams that have demonstrated a significant and lasting impact through the production of champion offspring which in turn is contributing to the strength and consistency of future generations. The Hall of Fame (HOF) recognizes individual dogs that have achieved the highest levels of accomplishment in conformation, performance, or companion events. Together, these programs serve to document and celebrate both influential breeding programs and outstanding individual achievement, ensuring that the history, quality, and legacy of the Schipperke are maintained for future generations.

The following are the SCA approved criteria for ROM/ROMX/HOF

Sires

ROM – 10 or more champion get

ROMX – 20 or more champion get

HOF – 25 or more champion get

Dams

ROM – 6 or more champion produced

ROMX – 10 or more champion produced

HOF – 12 or more champion produced

A dog may also qualify for the Hall of Fame through individual achievement. Any AKC-registered Schipperke that wins an All-Breed Best in Show (BIS) in the United States, automatically qualifies for an HOF certificate.

Additionally, an AKC-registered Schipperke may qualify for an HOF certificate by earning certain high-level companion or performance titles. These include Utility Dog Excellent (UDX), Obedience Trial Champion (OTCH), High in Trial (HIT) at an all-breed obedience trial (non-specialty), Master Agility Champion (MACH), Champion Tracker (CT), Versatile Companion Dog (VCD), Rally Advanced Excellent (RAE3), Preferred Agility Excellent (PAX2), FAST Century or Preferred (FTC/FTCP), Obedience Master (OM), Preferred Agility Champion (PACH), Search and Rescue (SAR-W/SAR-U), and Rally Champion (RACH).

A Dive into the Data:

The database currently has almost 7,000 recorded champions; let's take a look at an analysis of part of this data.

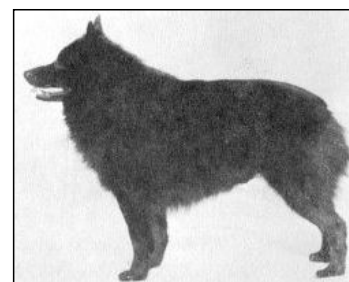

So, in general, sires producing 2.0 or more champions per dam can be considered exceptional, those in the 1.8–2.0 range are ROMX/ HOF level producers, and anything below 1.8 tends to reflect more volume-driven rather than efficiency. Overall, BISS BIS CH Sheradin When Spirits Talk ROMX-HOF stands out as the most efficient producer, CH Jetstar's Dhu Point ROMX-HOF is the most influential in terms of total output.

The data on the top-producing sires illustrates how a relatively small number of influential dogs can have a profound impact on both breed type and genetic diversity. As a result, their traits, such as head type, outline, movement, and temperament became widely established and helped define the modern look of the breed. Also noted, these sires appear repeatedly in pedigrees and their descendants are bred back into the same lines, the frequency of shared ancestors increases, leading to higher coefficients of inbreeding (COI). This can reinforce desirable and predictable traits; it may also reduce genetic diversity over time. Therefore, while these sires are invaluable for establishing and maintaining breed type, their influence should be considered thoughtfully to preserve both the quality and long-term health of the breed. One would also note the time in which these dogs were born. It seems presently the breeder mentality has shifted away from popular sire use.

A Modern-Day Example

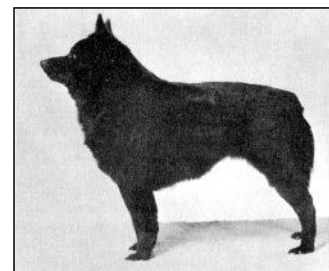

Unlike sires, which may be bred to many dams and can have sperm frozen to be used down the line, females are naturally limited in the number of litters they can produce. Therefore, when a bitch appears frequently in the database, it reflects not only her ability to produce and produce quality but also the intentional retention of her offspring within breeding programs. These bitches become the base of a strong bitch line. They tend to pass along type, structure, and temperament, which is why you often see them behind multiple successful dogs. It is worth noting that none of the top producing sires in the data were born after the year 2000, while several of the top producing bitches were born after 2000. This suggests a shift in how the breed is being bred. There seems to be less reliance on heavily used “popular sires” and more focus on maintaining strong bitch lines.

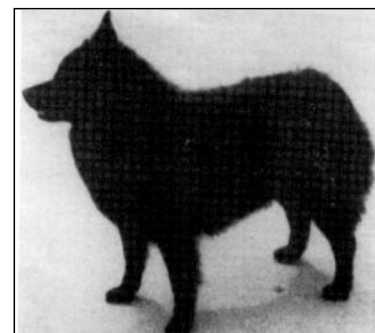

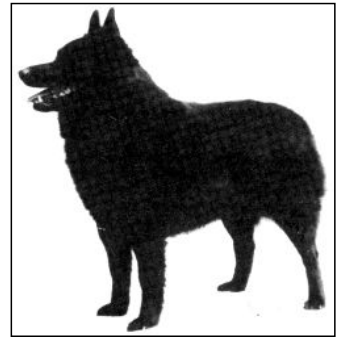

supportive. Although the tests are similar, there was a major difference. ABdFC test is pass / fail. NAWBA is scored similar to obedience (Novice has 190 possible points).

Glory was amazing on Saturday, passing ABdFC and scoring 187.5 points in NAWBA. We lost 2 points for not backing totally straight and a half-point because her left turn not quite a pivot. She earned two Novice Draft Dog Veteran (NDD-V) titles. She passed both tests on Sunday too. We improved our NAWBA score to 189.5 but lost 0.5 point for her right turn. She earned an Advanced Draft Dog Veteran (ADD-V) title from ABdFC. It was redeeming to pass under the judge from the Leonberger test. She was my first contact regarding carting and has been our greatest advocate.

Glory's summer adventure to earn a drafting title was a complete success.
Now to get Julee ready so I can have a Schipperke brace next year.
